#### Notes to the Condensed Consolidated Interim Financial Statements

PBA Holdings Bhd is a public limited liability company, incorporated and domiciled in Malaysia and is listed on the Main Market of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad.

The Condensed Consolidated Interim Financial Statements of the Group as at and for the period ended 30 June 2014 comprise the Company and its subsidiaries (together referred to as the Group) and the Group's interests in joint venture entity.

These Condensed Consolidated Interim Financial Statements were authorized for issue by Board of Directors on 21 August 2014.

#### 1. Basis of preparation

These condensed consolidated interim financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the applicable disclosure provisions of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad and MFRS 134, Interim Financial Reporting in Malaysia and with IAS 34, Interim Financial Reporting. They do not include all of the information required for full annual financial statements, and should be read in conjunction with the consolidated financial statements of the Group as at and for the year ended 31 December 2013.

#### 2. Significant accounting policies

#### 12. Review of Group performance

Group revenue for the quarter ended 30 June 2014 increased by RM2.6 million or 4.0% as compared to the preceding year corresponding quarter 2013. The increase was mainly due to the increase in consumption of water. Group profit before tax of RM8.4 million decreased by 30.4% as compared to the preceding year corresponding quarter of RM12.1 million due to the increase in cost of sales and administrative expenses.

#### 13. Variation of results against preceding quarter

Group revenue increased from RM65.5 million to RM67.1 million as compared to the immediate preceding quarter. Group profit before tax of RM8.4 million was higher by RM0.1 million compared to the immediate preceding quarter of RM8.3 million largely due to higher revenue.

#### 14. Current year prospects

Revenue from sales of water is expected to sustain for the year. Nevertheless, the Board continues to be mindful on measures implemented to mitigate escalating costs amidst prevailing economic conditions.
