PBA Holdings Bhd is a public limited liability company, incorporated and domiciled in Malaysia and is listed on the Main Market of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad.

1. Basis of preparation

2. Significant accounting policies

The Group's financial statements for annual period beginning on 1 January 2012 were prepared in accordance with the Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards (MFRSs) issued by the MASB and International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRSs).

The accounting policies adopted are consistent with those adopted for the annual financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2012 except for the adoption of IC Interpretation 18 ("IC Int 18") Transfers of Assets from Customers which is effective for financial period beginning on or after 1 January 2011.

IC Int 18 requires that all contributions (assets in the form of property, plant and equipment or cash to acquire such assets) received from customers, when that amount of contributions must be used only to construct or acquire an item of property, plant and equipment, and the item of property, plant and equipment is used to either connect the customer to a network or to provide the customer with ongoing access to supply of goods or services, or to do both, the contributions received are recognised as revenue. Revenue arising from assets received from customers are recognised in the income statement when the performance obligations associated with receiving those customer contributions are met.

The transferred assets which consist of mains and land, are recognised as an item of property, plant and equipment and are measured at their fair values on initial recognition with the corresponding amount recognised as deferred income.

The depreciation of mains and leasehold land and the amortisation of deferred income are recognised over their estimated useful lives ranging from 50 years to 99 years. Freehold land is not depreciated as it has an infinite life and revenue from such assets is recognised immediately in the year of transfer.

12. Review of Group performance

Group revenue for the quarter ended 30 September 2013 increased by RM3.5 million or 5.8% as compared to the preceding year corresponding quarter 2012. The increase was mainly due to the increase in consumption of water and trunk main contributions. Group profit before tax of RM3.6 million increased by 284.7% as compared to the preceding year corresponding quarter of RM1.2 million.

13. Variation of results against preceding quarter

Group revenue decreased from RM64.6 million to RM63.5 million as compared to the immediate preceding quarter. Group profit before tax of RM3.6 million was lower by RM7.3 million compared to the immediate preceding quarter of RM12.1 million largely due to higher maintenance and administrative expenses.

14. Current year prospects

Revenue from sales of water has shown improvement and the trend is expected to sustain for the year. Nevertheless, the Board continues with certain measures to mitigate escalating costs.
